Refund Policy. Players who officially request to withdraw from an event 7 days before the start of the event will receive 100% refund minus fees. If the request is between 2 and 7 days before the start of the event the player will receive 100% refund minus fee ONLY if their spot in the tournament is filled by a player who is on the waitlist. If the spot is NOT filled, the player will receive 50% refund or the players pack in case of Am player (if applicable). If the request is made sooner than 2 days from the start of the event there is no refund. Exceptions can be made in some cases.

Park Liaison:

Hamilton County: Tony and Bill Randolph went to the meeting, about 20 people showed up, ranging from rec to pro. The county had six people there plus H.B.. Current plan will use up to 26 acres, although HB is trying to get into a few areas that are off limit. The thought is to use one pad and have two baskets for each hole. Bill and I, along with many there, stressed the need for a more rec level course. There will be concrete tees and mulch around the baskets. The woodland mound tees signs were highly praised. I spoke with Kate McConnel and Mike Brech, and they both were letting me know that the club is a partner and will continue to be involved in this process. There was good communication and many thoughts, opinions and questions were discussed.
