For the Pros, \$10 of the \$45 will go the park, \$2 is ace fund and the rest is payout. For the Ams, \$10 is for the park, \$2 ace fund, \$2 club and then \$11 goes to Chains on Main who will pay out \$13. They will open after the event to accommodate the Am players.

September 2nd Flying Pig (Players Pack) Brochure to give out. Start with with pro pool and am pool then adjust as needed. Add shirt to players pack.

Refund Policy. Players who officially request to withdraw from an event 7 days before the start of the event will receive 100% refund minus fees. If the request is between 2 and 7 days before the start of the event the player will receive 100% refund minus fee ONLY if their spot in the tournament is filled by a player who is on the waitlist. If the spot is NOT filled, the player will receive 50% refund or the players pack in case of Am player (if applicable). If the request is made sooner than 2 days from the start of the event there is no refund. Exceptions can be made in some cases.
